

RULES FOR CAMPING AT THE **APPANOOSE COUNTY FAIR**

1. **Appanoose County Fair Board will make any and all final decisions as the need arises.**
2. All campsites \$100.
3. Campers may arrive on the grounds on July 17 and must vacate the premises by 1:00 p.m. on July 23.
4. Reselling or subletting a campsite will not be permitted.
5. NO electricity available for campsites. Generators are allowed.
6. **NO** generators may be operated before 6:30 a.m. or after 10:30 p.m. or at the discretion of the Appanoose County Fair Board.
7. Campers are allowed to hook up to the water located in the camping area only.
8. Camping is allowed **ONLY** in the designated areas.
9. Absolutely **NO** pets, livestock or horses allowed in the Camping area.
10. All road ways must be left open **NO parking** in the road ways.
11. If a camper is pulled from its campsite you are forfeiting your space.
12. There will be NO refunds of money paid for campsites.
13. No excessive noise, which may disturb other campers, will be permitted.
14. No drainage water or sewage may be disposed on the Appanoose County Fair grounds. If caught doing this you will be asked to leave immediately. THIS INCLUDES GRAY WATER.
15. Violation of any rule may be reason for immediate expulsion from the grounds without refund.
16. **NO bicycles, mopeds, or golf carts are allowed by campers on the Appanoose County Fair grounds.**
17. NO open fires.
18. EACH individual camping at the Appanoose County Fair grounds must hold a season ticket to the fair.
19. Must be 18 years of age or older to rent camping space.
